On behalf of the Milwaukee Repeater Club, which sponsors this 146.91 repeater, operating under the callsign of WI9MRC, I would like to welcome you to the Thursday Night Computer Net.

Everyone is invited to listen, and licensed Amateur Radio Operators, Technician class or higher, are encouraged to check in with traffic, or without. Traffic for this net means comments, questions, problems, or news about computers. If you have a computer that you would like to buy, sell or trade, we suggest that you check in on this frequency every Sunday at 9 PM to the Sunday Night Swapnet, where the buying and selling of Amateur Radio and related computer equipment is encouraged.

Also, be advised, traffic that will not be accepted for this net is the offering to distribute copyrighted programs without proper authorization.

In addition, we have been collecting a database of information of what type of computer each person has. That information can be made available to you so that you will know who to ask when you have a question that is computer type specific.

This is a directed net, which means that all communications are carried out at the direction of this net control station.

The call of the roll will be in alphabetical segments, based on the first letter following the numeral in your callsign. Mobile stations, who may get out of range, or reach their destinations, may ignore the roll call segments, and check in anytime. If you have emergency traffic during this net, please use the pro-word BREAK during the pause before the courtesy beep. We will then stop the net to handle your emergency traffic. That use of the word BREAK is our standard procedure on this very busy frequency. If you need the frequency with NO emergency, simply say your callsign before the beep, and you will be directed to go ahead as soon as possible. During check-in periods, please respond with only your callsign, in standard phonetics, and whether you have traffic or not.

We will now begin accepting check-ins in the segment of A-Alpha through D-Delta. Again, this is _____ (callsign), and my name is _____ (name).

A – Alpha through D – Delta, come now please.

A – Alpha through I - India, come now please.

A – Alpha through M - Mike, come now please.

A – Alpha through S - Sierra, come now please.

A – Alpha through V - Victor, come now please.

A – Alpha through Z - Zulu, come now please.
