Good evening. This is _____(callsign), my name is _____ and I am located in the (city/town) of _____.

On behalf of the Milwaukee Repeater Club, which sponsors this 146.91 repeater, operating under the callsign of WI9MRC, I would like to welcome you to the Sunday Night Swapnet. Everyone is invited to listen, and Amateur Radio Operators, Technician class or higher, are encouraged to check in, with traffic or without. The normal traffic this net handles is the listing of Amateur Radio, and related computer equipment that you would like to buy, sell or trade. All equipment should be your personal property unless you are handling the estate of an Amateur, or are relaying for an Amateur who cannot access this net.

This is a directed net, which means that all communications are carried out at the direction of this net control station. When I ask you specifically for your traffic, please respond with your name, location, telephone number with area code, or alternate frequency, and the items you wish to buy, sell or trade. If you are listing for an estate or another ham, please also list their name and callsign.

On this net, you may propose an asking price.

Be advised that communications in which the station licensee or control operator has a pecuniary interest, that is, communications on behalf of an employer, are not allowed. Amateur operators may however, notify other amateur operators of the availability for sale or trade of apparatus normally used in an amateur station. Negotiating or haggling on this net is not allowed.

The call of the roll will be in alphabetical segments, based on the first letter following the numeral in your callsign. Mobile stations, who may get out of range, or reach their destinations, may ignore the roll call segments and check in anytime.

If you have emergency traffic during this net, please say the pro-word BREAK during the pause before the courtesy beep. We will then stop the net to handle your emergency traffic. That use of the work BREAK is our standard procedure on this very busy frequency. If you need the frequency with NO emergency, simply say your callsign before the beep, and you will be directed to go ahead as soon as possible.

During check-in periods, please respond with only your callsign **in standard phonetics**, and whether you have traffic or not.

We will now begin accepting traffic in the segment of A-Alpha through C-Charlie. Again, this is _____(callsign), and my name is _____.

A-Alpha through C-Charlie come now please.

D-Delta through G-Golf come now please.

H-Hotel through J-Juliet come now please.

K-Kilo through M-Mike come now please.

N-November through P-Papa come now please.

Q-Quebec through S-Sierra come now please.
